

Introduction (Students)

Welcome to Allens RAMP (Reconciliation Action Mentoring Program). We hope that you find your involvement beneficial and rewarding.

Allens RAMP is open to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander law students. You do not have to decide, before joining the program, whether you want to be a commercial lawyer. Your involvement in RAMP may help you make that decision.

When your application is processed, you will be put in touch with your mentor who will be an Allens solicitor or law graduate. You will be able to experience what they do in their work, and to talk with them about your own studies and goals. Your contact with them may be in the form of an office visit, a coffee or lunch, or just by telephone or email. You and your mentor will contact each other as much or as little as you decide between you, but we hope that you will be in contact with your mentor at least once a month.

The purposes of mentoring are to give you:

- experience in the practice of the law from the perspectives of solicitors;
- general guidance and advice concerning a possible career in the law;
- encouragement to complete your education and to achieve personal goals; and
- self-confidence in your abilities, and in dealing with experiences and people outside your usual circles.
